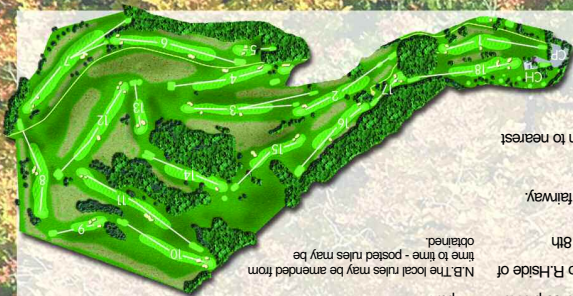

N.B. The local rules may be amended from time to time - posted rules may be obtained.

- (f) From worn areas outside Greenkeepers' compounds and adjacent to either the 4th fairway or the 6th fairway.
- (g) A ball coming to rest on any tee box other than the hole being played. N.B. In competitions marker must agree to any of the interferences with the line of putt the ball may be lifted and placed to preferred position no nearer the hole.
- 3.
  - (a) All storm damaged trees are to be treated as an integral part of the course.
  - (b) The drainage ditch behind the 14th green is an integral part of the course.
  - (c) The small fences guarding tee boxes are immovable obstructions and should be treated under Rule 24-2b.
  - (d) Stones in bunkers to be treated as movable obstructions Rule 24-1.
  - (e) Fixed sprinkler heads to be treated as Rule 24-2 and Appendix 1 Part B.

- (a) The hedges and fences enclosing the course shall be deemed the boundaries thereof.
  - (b) Inside white marker posts defining green-keepers compound including the wooded area and maintenance plot to 2nd, 16th and 17th fairways.
  - (c) In and beyond the hedge and white marked posts to R.H. side of 17th green.
  - (d) Beyond white marker posts to R.H. side of rough to 8th fairway.
  - (e) Beyond white marker posts to R.H. side of 10th green.
  - (f) Beyond white marker posts to R.H. side of the 18th fairway.
  - (g) Beyond the fence to the R.H. side of the 1st fairway.
- 2. WITHOUT PENALTY**
- (a) A ball may be lifted and dropped within one club-length to nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole when lying:-
  - (a) In hook marks and divot marks on fairways.
  - (b) On any road or loop-path.
  - (c) On any ground affected by course maintenance.
  - (d) On, or adjacent to, any limit stones embedded on the fairways.
  - (e) When lying within one club-length of the road on the fairways.
